Personal Emergency Plan

- Sufficient emergency cash on hand
 - Adequate supply of prescription medications
 - Photocopies of passport, plane ticket, and all other important documents
 - Emergency numbers contact card AND UC Trip Insurance Card on hand at all times
 - Know how to ask for help in local language
 - Cell phone charged and powered on: avoid turning off for long periods of time
 - Ready-made first aid kit
 - Check email daily
