James and Khadija Midgley Doctoral Dissertation Award

The **James and Khadija Midgley Doctoral Dissertation Award** is accepting applications from graduating doctoral students (those who intend to walk in the graduation ceremony in May, 2017).

This prestigious **\$3,000 cash award** will be offered to a single doctoral student in the School of Social Welfare who has shown intellectual curiosity, drive, and academic excellence while pursuing doctoral studies at U.C. Berkeley. The award will be presented at the annual Haviland Scholars Day on Friday, May 5, 2017.

Applicants should submit all of the following in a single package:

- (1) A cover letter describing the purpose and goals of their doctoral education at U.C. Berkeley.
- (2) A two-page description of their dissertation.
- (3) A current c.v. showing publications and/or presentations conducted during their doctoral career.
- (4) A letter of recommendation from the dissertation advisor.

Applications will be accepted until **April 14, 2017**.
