# Driving, Street Parking, and/or Walking or Biking to Haviland Hall

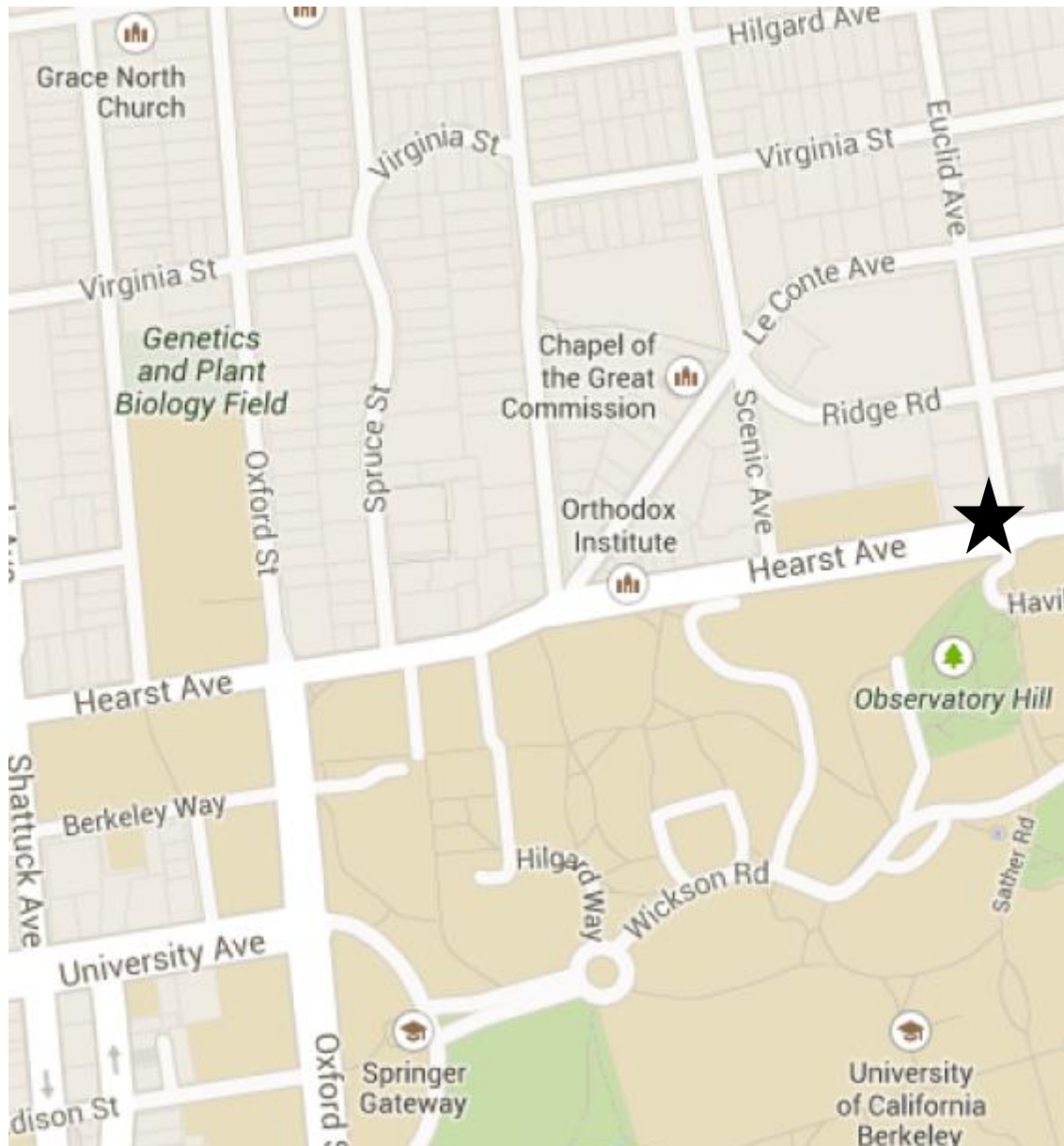
## Driving and Self-Parking on Street

If you plan to drive and self-park near Haviland Hall, We recommend searching for parking in a two-block radius around **the intersection of Hearst Avenue and Euclid Avenue in Berkeley, CA** (see map, next page). There are also spots on Ridge Road which is parallel to Hearst and intersects Euclid one block from campus.

Paid street parking is usually available for one to two hour increments. Some spots are metered (bring quarters) and others require you to purchase a parking ticket to place on your dashboard (credit cards work best). Please abide by all posted rules and watch the time closely. Tickets are frequently issued in this busy area. Please also note a ticket may also result from parking in a university lot on a faculty level without a proper permit.

# Walking, Biking, or Being Dropped Off

If you are walking, biking, or being dropped off, find **the intersection of Hearst Avenue and Euclid Avenue in Berkeley, CA** (indicated below by the star).



## **WALKING DIRECTIONS FROM INTERSECTION OF HEARST AND EUCLID TO HAVILAND HALL**

Where Hearst and Euclid intersect, CROSS HEARST Avenue in the crosswalk walking toward campus and away from Ridge Road.

You will see large columns ahead called “North Gate.” Walk toward them but DO NOT walk through them. Instead, veer OBLIQUE RIGHT down an asphalt path that leads downhill to Haviland Hall.

Following the asphalt path down to the base, you will pass a large campus map and emergency phone on the right and a green garbage/recycling bin on the left. Haviland Hall is the first building you will encounter at the bottom of the path on the left. You can enter the basement level on the ramp. A structure for parking and locking your bike is provided. The reception desk is located on the first floor, 120 Haviland, and many public events are located on the second floor in the Social Welfare Library.
