## **Attendance Policies:**

Unless otherwise arranged, students serve eight-hour business days following the agency's regular schedule. Lunch should be taken at the same time and increments as employees and does not count toward the eight hour daily service requirement. Regular attendance and punctuality are expected even when the student is serving remotely. Days of service are officially recorded at the end of each semester on the final evaluation form.

Students are allowed the equivalent of 2 weeks of sick leave per academic year (first year students are entitled to 4 days, and second year students to 6) that do not need to be made up. Absences beyond this must typically be made up. Some students may be approved in advance for additional accommodations based upon circumstance.

Unless otherwise arranged, students are not expected to be in field placement during university break periods; if mutually agreeable, students may rearrange break periods or make up absences during these periods. Before break, students are expected to arrange for continuity of care for all clients and projects.
